AUCTION	ALL LOTS offered for Sale must be offered for Sale by Auction. Any post Auction private transactions whilst the birds are in the Market must go through the Auctioneers Book.

Section 5 - GEESE: African, American Buff, Brecon Buff, Buff Back, Chinese, Embden, Grey Back, Pilgrim, Pomeranian, Roman, Sebastopol, Toulouse, West of England.

Section 6 - DUCKS: Abacot Ranger, Aylesbury, Blue Swedish, Buff Orpington, Campbell, Cayuga, Crested, Indian Runner, Magpie, Muscovy, Pekin, Rouen, Rouen Clair, Saxony, Silver Appleyard, Welsh Harlequin.
